The Academic Council was organized by Fr. Robert Kelley, the 16th president of Loyola University, in 1927. Fr. Kelley established the council to enable deans and regents of the various schools to acquaint themselves with the problems of other divisions; to help adjust conflict between divisions when they occurred; and to help the president make better informed decisions.
