### Administrative History

Established in 1983, the office of the Vice President of Student Services originated in 1929 as two separate offices for male and female students – the offices of the Dean of Men and the Dean of Women. These offices continued in existence until 1969. In 1946, the office of the Dean of Students was established with both the Dean of Men and Dean of Women reporting to the Dean of Students. In 1971, the former Dean of Men and Dean of Women offices were retitled Associate Dean of Students reporting to the Dean of Students. In 1973 the office of the Dean of Students was renamed the office of the Vice President of Student Services. In 1974, Mariette M. LeBlanc was appointed the first female Vice President for Student Services, where she served until her retirement in 1987. She previously served as Associate Dean and Dean of Students at the Water Tower Campus.

### Scope and Content

The Office of the Vice President of Student Services: Wayne Tinkle records comprise 2.25 linear feet spanning the years 1970-1973 and include student papers, scrapbooks, magazine and newspaper clippings, photographs, interoffice correspondence, flyers, information sheets, park usage applications, booklets, proposals, and templates. Arrangement is alphabetical and chronological.
