

Students— Haven't Received a Stimulus Payment Yet? Here's How to Get Yours!



You may be eligible for stimulus payments from the U.S. Federal Government. The payments are \$1,200 for single individuals and \$2,400 for married couples. For individuals or couples with children under 18, there is an additional \$500 added to each payment.

You are **eligible for a stimulus payment** if you are a U.S. citizen or permanent resident who:

- Has a valid Social Security number,
- Cannot be claimed as a dependent of another taxpayer, and
- Had adjusted gross income under certain limits— for example, those who make less than \$75,000 before taxes can receive \$1,200 in stimulus money.

You may also qualify for a stimulus payment by meeting either:

- The **green card test**, or
- The **substantial presence test**.
