

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR
LOYOLA UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO
DEFINED CONTRIBUTION RETIREMENT PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report for Loyola University of Chicago Defined Contribution Retirement Plan, EIN 36-1408475, for the period ended December 31, 2021. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefit Security Administration as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Basic Financial Statement

Benefits under the plan are provided by Trust.

Plan expenses were \$76,218,831. These expenses included \$431,352 in administrative expenses, \$75,754,817 of benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries, and \$32,662 in deemed distributions of participant loans. A total of 2,744 persons were active participants in or beneficiaries of the plan at the end of the plan year.

The value of the plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$1,170,700,472 as of December 31, 2021 compared to \$1,062,217,166 as of January 1, 2021. During the period, the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$108,483,306. This increase included unrealized appreciation or depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. The plan had total income of \$184,702,137 which consisted of employer contributions of \$18,345,526, employee contributions of \$21,141,434, other contributions of \$10,238,166, gain from investments of \$133,447,569 and other income of \$1,529,442.

If you request a copy of the full annual report from the plan administrator, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as part of that report. The charge to cover the copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.
