Robin Lovin recently retired as Cary M. Maquire University Professor of Ethics at SMU, a position that allowed him to write and teach about moral theology across different disciplines since 2001. Previously he served eight years as dean of SMU’s Perkins School of Theology. An ordained minister in the United Methodist Church, Lovin is past president of the Society of Christian Ethics and a former Guggenheim Fellow. He is the author of numerous books and papers, including most recently *An Introduction to Christian Ethics: Goals, Duties, and Virtues* (2011), *Christian Realism and the New Realities* (2008) and *Christian Ethics: An Essential Guide* (1999).
